Application for the NAPHA Junior Scholarship is open to NAPHA Junior Members who are in their Junior or Senior year of High School. A \$1000 scholarship will be paid directly to the school of higher learning in which the student is enrolled full time. It is the applicant's responsibility to send all required documents to the Scholarship Committee, so be sure to submit all items on this list:

- Autobiographical Essay
- Copy of High School Transcript
- Non-School Extracurricular Activity List (Use the NAPHA Non-School Extracurricular Activity form)
- School Extracurricular Activity List (Use the NAPHA School Extracurricular Activity form)
- Activities with Peruvian Horses (Use the NAPHA High Point Junior Exhibitor or Junior Horsemanship Program forms)
- Recommendation from a Teacher or Riding Instructor.

STUDENTS WHO MAIL ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO THE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE (UNLESS THAT INFORMATION IS SPECIFICALLY REQUESTED AS PART OF THE SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS) WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED FROM CONSIDERATION.
