

INSTRUCTIONS FOR REGISTERING A MALE (T) AS A BREEDING STALLION

In order to register a male for breeding purposes with NAPHA the following should be sent to the office:

- a) The original NAPHA certificate of registration.
- b) Veterinarian's Statement for a Breeding Stallion – this form can be found on the NAPHA website under Registration Forms.
- c) Photographs:
 - (1) Full profile/side view of right side
 - (2) Full profile/side view of left side
 - (3) Full face/frontal view
 - (4) Full rear view.

All four legs must be seen from both sides; markings on face must be visible.

All photos should include **all parts** of the animal available in that view (ears to hooves or nose to tail inclusive) and be unobstructed by any other object or animal.

Additional photos should be submitted to verify markings not seen in the standard four photos (i.e., white on belly, markings under mane area, etc).

Please label each photo with first choice of name and owner's name on the back.

Photos must be a minimum of 3" x 5" and a maximum of 4 x 6". We accept digital photos if printed on quality photographic paper. We do not accept color copy photos.



- d) Fee to register a Breeding Stallion – please see current fee schedule.
- e) DNA typing – please see current fee schedule. DNA kit will be emailed or mailed upon receipt of payment(s).
- f) Paperwork submitted incomplete, missing photos or fees will be subject to return and a \$ 15 rejection fee– please see current fee schedule.
