MINUTES OF THE MAY 13, 2020 NAPHA BOARD OF DIRECTORS' MEETING

Treasurer's report was given by Heidi Opdyke. Amounts in the Wells Fargo Checking and Savings accounts were presented.

Discussion: We are trying to close the Citibank accounts. All monies will be moved into the new Wells Fargo checking or savings accounts.

The storage units in California have still not been emptied. No more payments will be made to maintain these units. This will be a saving of over \$4800 a year.

NAPHA has received the final amount of the grant that was applied for from the City of Scottsdale for last year's national show.

Other NAPHA shows have been cancelled and the regions are waiting to see what will be happening on those remaining scheduled shows.

Section 1 – Judges.

Section 3 - Class fees

Section 4 - Classes

Discussion -

Perhaps the 1st place horse in each division would be invited to the National without having to qualify.

Perhaps there could be Sale Classes.

A motion was made by Gail Benson and seconded by Edie Gandy to accept the classes and requirements of rides as listed.

Motion passed.

Section 5 - Timeline and date of show.

Motion was made by Gail Benson and seconded by Heidi Opdyke to accept the timeline and date of show.

Section 6 - Classes.

Motion was made by Gail Benson and seconded by Edie Gandy to accept all registered Peruvian horses into the Virtual Show.

Section 7 - Award & Budget

A small ribbon will be awarded to all first place horses.

First through Fifth place ribbons would be awarded award to all Youth classes.

Motion was made by Edie Gandy and seconded by Gail Benson to give a first price ribbon to all class except the Youth classes would be awarded first through fifth place.

Section 8 - Show Name

The committee had several name suggestions for the show. The Board asked the committee to come back with the name of the show as long as "NAPHA" was in the name

Further discussion of Virtual Show:

The required attire was being considered by the committee.

There would be no Gait classes.

All participants will need to sign a waiver allowing NAPHA the use of their videos for future use.

The committee will look at conflicts of interest for any of the chosen judges if they have horses that will be entering in the virtual show.

Discussion:

NAPHA will be holding an online auction. Edie Gandy will get in contact with a company she is familiar with that does online auctions for nonprofit organizations.

The information would go out to all NAPHA members and additional 500,000 people that the company has on file.

The fee is \$600 plus a percentage of the sales.

Photos of the items are uploaded. We would solicit for items on social media and website.

They timing of the auction would be between the virtual show and the National Show.

The auction could also be advertised during the virtual show.
