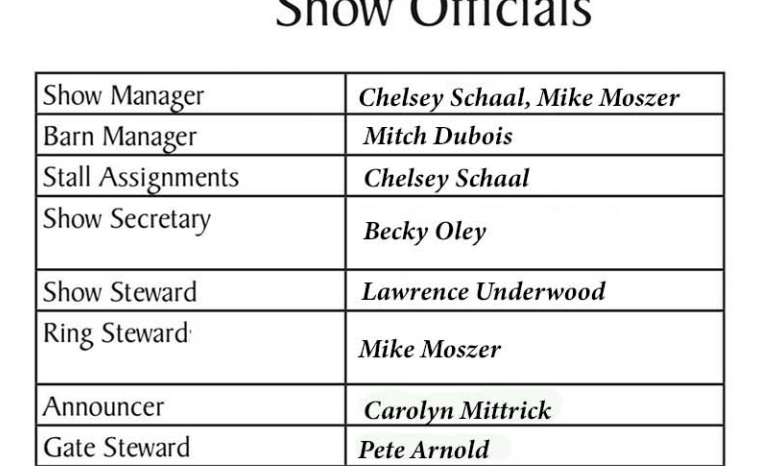

**Enfrises:** This show is open to all horses registered with NAPHA (formerly PPHRNA & AAOBPPH) or the PHAC. Horses must be entered based upon the current registration papers, registered owner and full registered name and number. Horses must be entered under the full registered name. Make horses 4 years of age and older must be registered as a stallion or gelding. Registration papers indicating "male" will not be considered acceptable registration papers. The only exception will be male horses entered in Colts 3-4 in Bozal. Spayed mares may not be shown as breeding mares.

**Proof of Ownership:** A copy of the horse's current Registration papers MUST accompany Entry Form. Entries cannot be processed without them.

**Post Entries:** Are accepted by the Show Secretary 1/2 hour before classes start in the morning. Be sure to bring paperwork for post entries.

**Scratching/Withdrawing Entry:** SSPPHC agrees to refund entry fees on any horse that is physically unable to compete, provided a Veterinary Statement certifying inability to compete is received in the Show office 3 classes prior to the class the horse has been entered. Other entries must be scratched 3 classes prior to their respective classes in order to have fees refunded.

**Adding Classes:** There will be no additional charge other than normal class fees for adding classes to a horse already entered.

**Refunds:** Refunds cannot be made without valid written veterinary excuse. NO refunds will be approved after the closing of the show.

**Substituting:** In the event your horse is unable to compete, another eligible horse from the same ranch may be substituted with additional charge.

**Responsibility:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that NAPHA, SSPPHC and Stevens County Expo will not be held responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims.

**Stabling With Someone Else:** If you wish to be stabled next to someone, indicate so on the Entry Form. We will do our best to honor all stall requests. Please advise us of your stabling preferences on your Entry Form. Also, please note whether you prefer stalls on concrete or those with dirt floors on your Entry Form. Be advised that there are a limited number of stalls with concrete floors.

**Early Arrival and Late Departure:** This facility can accommodate arrivals after 12:00 noon on Wednesday, May 25, 2022.

**All Stalls Are To Be Vacated By 10:00am on Monday, May 30, 2022.**

**Shavings:** Exhibitors are required to purchase all shavings at the Stephens County Expo. NO outside shavings are allowed. Pre-ordered shavings can be at your stalls if requested on your Entry Form. All shavings will be billed on your show invoice.

**Items To Bring To The Show:** Exhibitors are advised to bring all items necessary for the showing and care of their horses such as feed and water buckets, hay feeders, feed, hay, supplements, grooming supplies, fans, garden hoses, stable fork, fly sprays, etc... Bring tack room equipment such as saddle racks, head gear hooks, brooms, folding chairs, wheelbarrow, muck bucket, ice chest, etc...

**Drug Free Show:** This is a Drug-Free show and will be run under the rules and guidelines of the USEF. You can access all the pertinent information at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). Be advised that Bute and Banamine are specifically referenced in the USEF literature as being illegal drugs in the show setting.

**Lead-Line:** This class is open to children 6 years of age and younger. Tack and attire will be the same as for regular classes.

**Drug Free Show:** This is a Drug-Free show and will be run under the rules and guidelines of the NAPHA. You can access the list of prohibited substances at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). Be advised that Bute and Banamine are specifically referenced in the USEF literature as being illegal drugs in the show setting.

Each exhibitor agrees to be bound by the drug rules and penalties under the rules. Any horse entered in a class is subject to examination by a licensed veterinarian. Such examination may include physical, salivary, urine and/or blood tests at the discretion of the veterinarian.

Drug testing will be conducted during lunch on Sunday, randomly testing horses qualified for Ch and Res or Ch of Ch classes.

CAUTION: Refusal to submit a horse for examination, whether in competition or not, or to cooperate with the veterinarian and technicians will result in the suspension of the rider, constitutes a violation and subjects the responsible person to the penalties under SSPPHC and NAPHA rules. SEE: Section 13 NAPHA Rules and Regulations Of Horse Showing and Peruvian Breed Standards.

**Health Certificates:** A Health Certificate, signed by a veterinarian within 30 days of this show, is required and must be presented prior to unloading horses.

**Coggins Report:** All horses are required to have proof of negative Coggins test dated less than one year prior to date of show. A current copy of Coggins test must accompany Entry Form. The original Coggins report must accompany each horse and be presented prior to unloading horses.

**Veterinarian Examination:** All animals are subject to a physical examination by the show veterinarian, as a safeguard against communicable equine disease. If a horse is found to have a communicable disease, it must immediately leave the grounds.

**Judge's Authority:** The Judge shall have the authority to place any horse in whatever position in a class that he/she thinks the merit of the horse justifies. The Judge has the right to make favorable comments over the public address system about the horses shown before him, but shall make no negative comments.

**Substitutions of Show Officials:** In the event that the Judge (or other officials assigned herein) is unable to perform his duties due to circumstances beyond his control or for any other reason, SSPPHC reserves the right to substitute another approved official in his/her place.

## Class Notes

**Class Routine:** Horses enter the ring at their best gait, lining up in the center in front of the Judge or Ring Steward for inspection. The inspection in the line is for conformation and condition.

**Champagne Class:** The rider with the most liquid remaining in his/her glass at the end of the class is the winner. The horses must gait, not walk. Optional exercises can be implemented to add to the enjoyment of the class. Ties can be broken with an additional exercise. Ponchos are optional. Bit or bozal.

**Versatility Horse of Show:** The horse must enter at least five of the designated classes as shown in the class list.

**Champion and Champion of Champions Classes:** Champions and Champion of Champions from shows other than Sooner State or the National Show must qualify to enter the Champion class at this show. Returning Champion of Champions not participating in any other classes at this show must pay \$65 entry fee if member or \$75 if non-member.

**Adult Attire:** Ladies: a white or cream-colored mid-calf to ankle-length riding skirt may be substituted for white pants. Sidesaddle attire: See NAPHA rules. Dress/habit should be conservative and appropriate for equestrian attire - not dances or costume balls.

**Junior Attire:** White pants, white shirt, black or brown boots and belts, hats either Peruvian or other straw type hat. Riders ages 12 & under, and lead-line are required to wear helmets, with bicycle-type helmets being acceptable. Helmets are highly recommended for ages 13-18. Ponchos are allowed in classes other than equitation. On any horse ridden in Peruvian tack by a junior in ANY class, retractions are prohibited, batcola is required and floor is optional.

**Junior Qualifying Ages:** Juniors are those individuals who have not yet reached their eighteenth birthday. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on January 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire show. Persons born on January 1 shall assume the greater age on that date. The deadline classes are exceptions, wherein a child must have attained the age of 24 months before the show. The minimum age for participation in other Junior classes is set at 6 years.

**Barrack:** Barrack pads without stirrups are in championship classes.

**Barrida of Champions:** Includes all Champions, Barrack of Champions, Best Gaited, Best Bozal, Versatility Horse of Show, High Point

**Call for Classes:** Classes will be called promptly and with advance notice. Exhibitors shall present themselves to the gate steward in a timely manner, facilitating preparations for the class. After the first horse enters the arena, remaining entries will have 5 minutes to enter prior to closing of the gate. While this is usually sufficient, exhibitors requiring a tack change may request it in advance. Approval of the tack change adds an additional 2 minutes - for a total of 7 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. The gate will remain open during this time or until all entries have entered the arena. No judging will occur while the gate is open, although the Judge may observe the general condition of the horse in the arena.

**Conduct:** Each exhibitor while on the show grounds will display his horse in the most natural way possible and show his/her horse in a suitable manner. Exhibitors shall at all times take whatever steps are necessary to protect themselves, their horses and the viewing public. The Show Management reserves the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. It is mandatory for a Judge or a Show Steward to dismiss any rider or handler (and his/her horse) who deliberately interferes with another entry or who displays unsportsmanlike behavior in the arena or within sight of the spectators at the arena. It should also be noted that no warnings are ever necessary. \*\*\*Part IX, Section 15, NAPHA Show Rules\*\*\*

**Everything is Being Done** to conduct this show at the highest level and to the fullest extent of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudication officials to be found have been selected and they will award placement to the horses as they see them presented in the ring, without regard for previous records or performances. The SSPPHC desires of fair treatment for all exhibitors and in return ask for the cooperation of all in helping to make this show a successful and enjoyable event.
