# SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

**Entries:** This show is open to all horses registered with NAPHA (formerly PPHRNA & AAOBPPH) or the PHAC. Horses must be entered based upon the current registration papers, registered owner and full registered name and number. Horses must be entered under the full registered name.

Male horses 4 years of age and older must be registered as a stallion or gelding. Registration papers indicating "male" will not be considered acceptable registration papers. The only exception will be male horses entered in Colts 3-4 in Bozal. Spayed mares may not be shown as breeding mares.

**Proof of ownership:** A copy of the horses' current Registration papers must accompany Entry Form. Entries cannot be processed without them.

**Post Entries:** Are accepted by the show secretary 1/2 hour before classes start in the mornings. Be sure to bring paperwork for post entries.

**Adding Classes:** There will be no additional charge other than normal class fees for adding classes to a horse already entered.

**Refunds:** Refunds cannot be made without valid written veterinary excuse. No refunds will be approved after the closing of the show.

**Substituting:** In the event your horse is unable to compete, another eligible horse from the same ranch may be substituted without additional charge.

**Responsibility:** All entries are accepted with the understanding that NAPHA, CdPPHS, CSPHC and Stormont Vail Event Center will not be held responsible for any loss, personal injury or damage to horses exhibited or for any injury that maybe occasioned to any person or any animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all claims or damages of any kind or nature, including attorney fees and court costs that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him/her or arising from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All Exhibitors, Handlers, Riders and Other Persons participating in this show are responsible for a thorough knowledge of and are subject to the current NAPHA Official Rules & Regulations of Horse Showing & Peruvian Paso Breed Standards, NAPHA Official Rules & Regulations of Registration & By-Laws.

Remember, NO advertising on shirts. All showing procedures and judging percentages as well as definitions, class descriptions of gear and attire, rules and regulations, conduct and ethics, and conditions for this show are described in the above-named publications. These publications may be downloaded from the NAPHA website: [www.napha.net](http://www.napha.net)

**Amateur Status:** Anyone competing in a class or division declared for Amateurs only must have a written Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA. New rules are in place for amateurs and novices. Amateur Level 1 and Level 2: All amateur exhibitors are required to declare their level (1 or 2) riding status prior to the beginning of the show. The criteria for declaration are as follows:

**Amateur Level 1:** Exhibitor/Rider has won 5 or fewer Champion of Champions titles (from any NAPHA approved or Canadian show) in the last 5 years.

**Amateur Level 2:** Exhibitor/Rider has won MORE THAN 5 Champion of Champions titles from any NAPHA approved or Canadian show in the last 5 years. All current (non-professional) NAPHA carded judges will automatically sign as Level 2. Any Exhibitor/Rider may declare as a Level 2 rider if they have not won the 5 title requirement, are unsure, or feel that their skill level is more appropriate for Level 2.

If a horse qualifies for the Champion/Reserve class with a level 1 rider, only a level 1 rider is allowed to complete competition in that division. The same rule applies if the horse qualifies for Champion of Champions. (Different level 1 riders can compete on the same horse for that division.

If an Exhibitor/Rider who qualifies as a Level 1, chooses to compete at Level 2, He/She cannot return to a Level 1 status. Any horse regardless of the rider's Level 1 or 2 status that wins 3 Champion of Champion Performances in any combination of levels in their respective show, shall have achieved the Laureado and is not eligible to compete in either level of Amateur Performance in the respective show. While this is an honor system, if any Exhibitor/Owner protests another exhibitor's title count, it will be the responsibility of the inquiring exhibitor/owner to provide documented proof to the CdPPHS/CSPPHC Board of Directors. If the complaint is verified by the Board of Directors, the violating exhibitor will be disqualified and must surrender all applicable awards and points to the CdPPHS/CSPPHC for redistribution within 30 days of notification.

**Amateur Owner to Ride (AOTR):** Rider must be amateur and registered owner of the horse. Novice Class: Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Novice" only must have a signed NAPHA Novice Declaration on file with the N APRA. Novices must file this form annually. An exhibitor (18 years and older) can compete in the Novice Division for a period of 3 years. If the Novice, at the end of 3 years, has not competed in more than 8 NAPHA-approved shows during that period, they may extend the time period for another 3 years (double shows count as one show). However, if at any time, a Novice competes and wins a Champion title in gait, breeding or performance (any other division above the level of Novice) they will be Immediately excluded from competing in the Novice Division at future shows.

**Juniors:** Juniors are those individuals who have not yet reached their eighteenth (18th) birthday. For horse show purposes, the age of an individual on January 1 of the current year shall be maintained throughout the entire show year. Junior classes 12 and younger and 13 and older will run together as a single class, but will be judged separately. Retrancas are not allowed, baticola (crupper) required and florons are acceptable. Juniors may only ride mares and geldings. Helmets are required for 6-12 and lead line and are encouraged for 13-18.

**Owner:** The name on the certificate of ownership issued by the NAPHA, and their minor children are allowed to ride AAOBPPH, PPHRNA, or PHAC,. If the horse is owned by a ranch, corporation or a family trust, the individuals' names must be registered with the NAPHA.

**NEW: IMPORTANT ---** Luxury Geldings, Breeding Mares & Stallions National or returning Champion of Champions and any horse that has qualified for Champion and Reserve Luxury Gelding, Breeding Mare or Breeding Stallion classes **MUST ENTER** their respective Zootecnico class on Sunday. The Show Secretary will automatically enter all national returning Champions and this show's first and second place class winners into their respective Zootecnico class. It is not required that a first or second place enter the Ch. and Res. Class. The Show Secretary must be notified before the time class 45 is called if a horse will not be competing in the Zootecnico, Ch and Res or Ch of Ch class that day. No refunds will be given for the Zootecnico or Ch and Res classes if the Show Secretary is not notified before the time class 45 is called. See the Refund Policy for additional information.

**Stalling With Someone Else:** If you wish to be stalled next to someone, indicate so on the Entry Form. We will do our best to honor all stall requests. Please advise us of your stalling preferences on your Entry Form.

**Early Arrival and Late Departure:** This facility can accommodate arrivals after 12:00 noon on Wednesday, May 20, 2026. All Stalls Are To Be Vacated By 10:00am on Monday, May 25, 2026. If you plan to arrive before 12:00 noon Wednesday, please call our Barn Manager. He or his assistant will be on the grounds throughout the show. Barn Manager: Mike Moszer 612-787-8864

**Shavings:** Exhibitors are required to purchase all shavings at the Stormont-Vail Events Center. NO outside shavings are allowed. Pre-ordered shavings can be at your stalls if requested on your Entry Form. All shavings will be billed on your show invoice.

**Drug Free Show:** This is a Drug-Free show and will be run under the rules and guidelines of the USEF. You can access all the pertinent information at [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org). Be advised that Bute and Banamene are specifically referenced in the USEF literature as being illegal drugs in the show setting.

There will be no stripping of tack during Champion of Champion classes.

All additions, Scratches, Changes of Rider/Handler, Tack Changes should be submitted to the Show Office on the Official Form, three (3) classes prior.

**Tack:** Work saddles and flat bridles may be used if clean and in good condition. Spurs of Bumper type are permitted in all classes for Juniors. Peruvian, English, Western, Plantation, Spanish-Lite, Peruvian Trail or Australian gear is acceptable. Don West saddles are permitted. Combining or mixing of different types of gear not permissible except that the Peruvian bit with Peruvian or other curb chain CAN be used with any head gear (Peruvian bit is not mandatory).

Everything is Being Done to conduct this show at the highest level and for the pleasure of exhibitors and spectators. The best adjudication officials to be found have been selected and they will award placement to the horses as they see them presented in the ring, without regard for previous records or performances. The CdPPHS and CSPHC are desirous of fair treatment for all exhibitors and in return ask for the cooperation of everyone in helping to make this show a successful and enjoyable event.

**Call for Classes:** Classes will be called promptly and with advance notice. Exhibitors shall present themselves to the gate steward in a timely manner to facilitate preparations for the class. After the first horse enters the arena, remaining entries will have 5 minutes to enter prior to closing of the gate. While this is usually sufficient time, exhibitors requiring a tack change may request it in advance. Approval of the tack change adds an additional 2 minutes - for a total of 7 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. The gate will remain open during this time or until all entries have entered the arena. No judging will occur while the gate is open, although the Judge may observe the general condition of the horses in the arena.

**Conduct:** Each exhibitor while on the show grounds will display his horse in the most natural way possible and maintain his/her horse in a suitable manner. Exhibitors shall at all times take whatever steps are necessary to protect themselves, their horses and the viewing public. The Show Management reserves to itself the right to remove a groom, horse, rider or handler from the show without being liable for compensation or damages. It is mandatory for a Judge or a Show Steward to dismiss any rider or handler (and his/her horse) who deliberately interferes with another entry or displays unsportsmanlike behavior in the arena or within sight of the spectators at the arena. It should also be noted that no warnings are ever necessary.

### **\*\*\*Part IX, NAPHA Show Rules\*\*\***

**Special Awards:** New this year, High Point Awards will combine the points from both the Caballo Show and Centennial Club for Heartland Classic Peruvian Horse Show Awards. High Point Versatility Horse, High Point Breeder, High Point Horse, High Point Crystal Horse (12+ yoa), High Point Bozal, High Point Amateur - Heart of the Horse Perpetual Trophy, High Point Novice, High Point Jr. (6-12 yoa), Reserve High Point Jr. (6-12 yoa), High Point Jr. (13-18 yoa), Reserve High Point Jr. (13-18 yoa). In the Jr. division, highest placing in the Jr. Performance Pattern Class will serve as tiebreaker. Tiebreaker in HPO and HPB will be the highest number of horses in each category (Breeder or Owner). Tiebreaker in Bozal, Crystal and HPH will be placing in their respective Breeding Class. Tiebreaker for HPA will be total number of classes entered. 2nd tiebreaker in all cases will be by flip of a coin by the Show Manager with both parties present.

**Class Routine:** Horses enter the ring at their best gait, turn right along the rail, then line up in the center of the arena in front of the Judge or Ring Steward for inspection. The inspection in the line is for conformation and condition. Please be alert to the announcer and Ring Steward for any changes in this routine.

**Champagne Class:** The rider with the most liquid in his/her glass at the end of the class is the winner. The horses must gait -not walk. Optional exercises can be implemented to add to the enjoyment of the class. Ties can be broken with additional maneuvers. Ponchos are optional. Bit or bozal.

**Junior attire:** White pants, white shirt, black or brown boots and belts, hats either Peruvian or other straw hat. Riders ages 12 & under, and leadline are required to wear helmets. Bicycle-type helmets are acceptable. Helmets are highly recommended for ages 13-18. Vests and Blazers are allowed for all classes. Ponchos are allowed in classes other than equitation. On any horse ridden in Peruvian tack by a Junior in ANY class: retrancas are prohibited, baticola is required and floron is optional.

**Champion and Champion of Champions Classes:** Champions and Champion of Champions from shows other than Sooner State or National show must qualify to enter the Championship classes at this show. Returning Champion of Champions not participating in any other classes at this show must pay \$135 entry fee.

**Barrida of Champions:** Includes all Champions, Champion of Champions, Best Gaited, Best Bozal, High Point Breeder, High Point Amateur, (High Point Junior 13 years and over may participate with parents' consent)

**Ladies to Ride and Gentlemen to Ride Classes:** Entries may be asked to perform movements such as stop, back up, circle once or twice in gait, reverse and serpentine through cones.

**Tack:** Work saddles and flat bridles may be used if clean and in good condition. Spurs of Bumper type are permitted in all classes for Juniors. Peruvian, English, Western, Plantation, Spanish-Lite, Peruvian Trail or Australian gear is acceptable. Combining or mixing of different types of gear not permissible except that the Peruvian bit with Peruvian or other curb chain CAN be used with any head gear (Peruvian bit is not mandatory).

**Stakes Payout:** The Purse will be 80% of the gate entry fees, with 1st place - 30%, 2nd place 25%, 3rd place - 15%, 4th place -10%. (Amateurs are allowed to accept prize money, "AS THE OWNER OF A HORSE IN ANY CLASS OTHER THAN EQUITATION OR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES")(as per NAPHA Show Rules).

**NAPHA Rules pertaining to Amateur/Professional and Novice Rules:** Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Amateurs" only must have a signed NAPHA Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA. Amateurs must file annually. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur if after their 18th birthday, they have not engaged in any of the activities identified in PART X Glossary of Terms, Section 10 Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules.

Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under NAPHA rules must have signed a NAPHA Amateur Declaration filed with the Show Secretary, on submitted on the NAPHA website prior to the start of the class entered. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. See Part X GLOSSARY OF TERMS for complete definition of amateur and Professional, in the NAPHA Show Rules.

**Optional - Special Attire - For all novice and Amateur Classes:** To promote participation and allow competitors to try something other than the normal white attire, we have developed guidelines for other color clothing in the Novice and Amateur Classes. This is NOT mandatory, rather an option for those who would like to try something different. If you decide to ride with alternative Attire, please follow the below specified rules:

**Approved clothing colors:** Black, shades of grey (charcoal to light), browns (dark to tan/beige, khaki), shades of muted greens (olive to hunter), small pinstripes, light blue or dark navy, burgandy (no bright reds), white, creams, ivory.

**Hat:** Must be of Peruvian type as currently outlined in NAPHA Rules unless matching an attire such as Western.

**No Ponchos:** Blazer or Suit-style Vest MUST be worn, if wearing alternative attire.

**Boots & Belt:** In colors and type as currently outlined in the NAPHA Rules. Boots allowed to be worn outside of pants. Polinas allowed in same range of colors. Alternative Color Vests/Jackets allowed in colors as outlined above. If using non-Peruvian tack, please wear vests/jackets in colors outlined above.

**Shirts:** Collared, long-sleeved shirt in white or colors as outlined above.

**Slacks/Pants:** must be sufficiently long enough to cover ankle and boot tops unless the boots are being worn outside of the pants. Jeans in above solid colors. Please, no casual looking blue jeans.

**Split skirts or sidesaddle aprons for women:** As provided for in the NAPHA Rules, also in above colors.

**Scarves and Ties:** Traditional white scarf, Peruvian style, bolo tie, or Western crisscross tie in above outlined colors, or necktie and brooch.

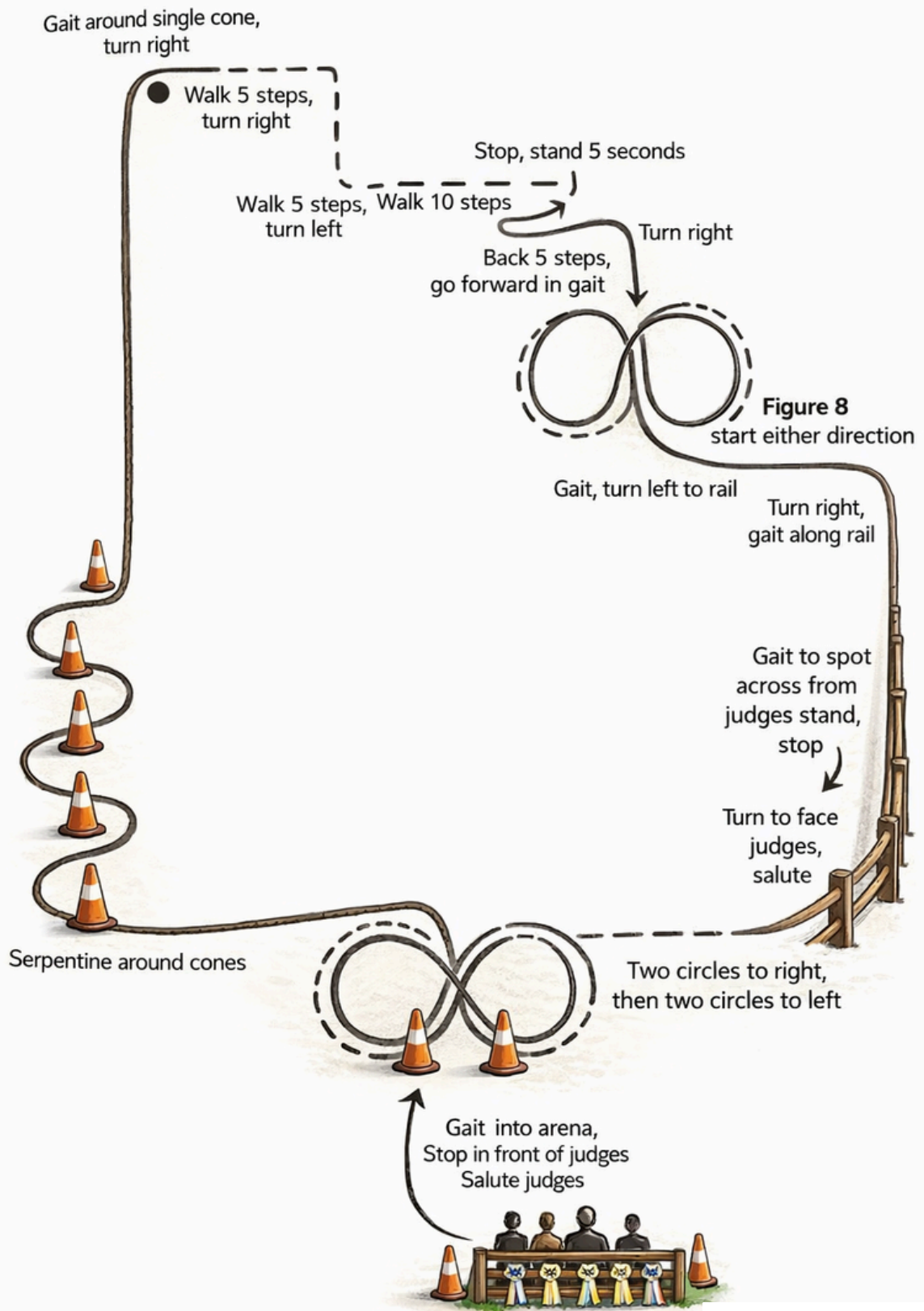
